

Tutor Parent Contract:

Our student to student tutoring program connects student tutors, Grades 8-12, to families. Tutors are expected to encourage, explain and take the time through various lessons so that the student can gain a better understanding of the concepts where they are having difficulty. Our program aims to enhance a student's learning, offer affordable tutoring for parents, and build mentoring skills in teen tutors. This is not a professional program.

Sessions can be arranged during the Library open hours, depending on a tutor's schedule.

Library Hours:

Monday-Thursday 9am-8pm, Friday 9am-6pm, Saturday 10am-4pm, Sunday 12-4pm.

Cost is \$12/hour. Fees (cash or cheques) are to be paid directly to the tutor at the beginning of each month for the upcoming sessions.

We ask that you contact your child's tutor at least the evening prior, should your child be unable to make it to their booked session. We are unable to contact tutors during the school day, and as they show up expecting to work, they should be paid accordingly. Tutoring will not continue if fees are not paid.

It is essential the parent of the student be in communication with the tutor.
