

Student to Student Tutoring Parent Contract:

As the Beaumont Library now has capacity and social distancing guidelines in place, the tutoring program is online only. Families will need access to a device (computer, laptop, iPad) with a camera.

The tutors (Gr. 9-12 honour students) are expected to encourage and explain various lessons/homework for the student to gain a better understanding of the concepts.

Our program aims to enhance a student's learning, offer affordable tutoring for parents, and build mentoring skills in teen tutors. This is not a professional tutor program.

Our Tutoring Coordinators will assist in connecting families & tutors on an online platform (to be determined) and sorting out any online issues they may encounter.

The tutoring sessions will be for one hour at \$12/hr with an option for the Kindergarten to Grade 3 children of two sessions/week of 30 minutes each. Fees (cash or cheques) are to be paid directly to the tutor at the beginning of each month for the upcoming sessions. We ask that you contact your child's tutor at least the evening prior, should your child be

unable to make it to their booked session. It is essential the parent of the student be in communication with the tutor.
