# Holidays and class schedules

The following days are holidays and there will be no dance classes at this time or on a long weekend:

**Thanksgiving :** Octobre 9 to 11

**Remembrance Day :** November 11th (Classes will be rescheduled)

**Christmas Holidays :** The office will be closed from December 19 to January 3

**Family Day :** February 19 to 21

**Spring Holidays :** March 26 to April 2

**Easter:** April 15 to 18

NB. There will be dance classes on PD days unless it is also a long weekend or a statutory holiday (see calendar).

## **Important information regarding classes**

- Schedule adjustments can be made until the end of September 2021.
- A minimum number of 3 registrations will be required to start traditional dance classes. If the number of participants is less than 3 registrations, the administration will find possible alternatives which will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.
- One-on-one classes may be offered at the discretion of the teacher if there is only one registered child in the class. This only applies for ballet/jazz and contemporary classes.
- The maximum number per class is 9 participants. We encourage you to register your child as early as possible as our registrations will be based on a first come, first served policy. If more than 9 students are interested, we can potentially add a second class for this group but we cannot guarantee it.
- Sometimes it is possible that year-long class will be canceled for the remainder of the season. In this case, a prorated refund of the course and the production costs will be granted to the families. Membership fees will not be refunded.
- If La Girandole's studios need to close due to Covid-19 restrictions, we will notify you and continue the dance lessons virtually until the studios can safely reopen.

# Annual fundraiser

Regardless of your chosen fundraising method, a deposit of \$ 250 must be given by postdated check for May 1, 2022 upon registration. La Girandole reserves the right to cash it if the fundraising or volunteer hours are not completed in full and on time.

Each year, all parents are required to choose one of the following five volunteering options:

## A. Fundscrip

Fundscrip is a website that allows the purchase of gift cards for several stores (Superstore, The Keg, Starbucks, Esso, Aldo, etc.). You must reach a value of 250\$ in profits for the Association.

# Dance school policies

## **Payment:**

The following payment methods will be accepted: check, débit, credit card or e-transfer ([administration@lagirandole.com](mailto:administration@lagirandole.com)).

### **Option A :**

1 payment (full payment for the year)

### **Option B :**

2 payments (1 payment at registration in Septembre - half the payment or more and 2nd payment in January - the remaining amount).

## **Discounts:**

- Pre-registration: receive \$ 20 off each course if you register your child between August 9 and 27.
- When registering two or more members of the same family, or if a dancer registers for more than one course, you will receive a 10% discount on the total course cost.
- Scholar program: This program is offered to youth wishing to develop their full potential in dance and aspire to join the Zéphyr dance troupe in the future. The dancer must be enrolled in a minimum of 3 classes, one of them being a traditional dance class. If this is the case, you will receive a 25% on the traditional dance class and a 10% discount on the 2 other classes.

\* Discounts are only applied to the class fee, not the production or membership fees.

## **Refund**

Each dancer is entitled to a free trial class during the first week of the season. You have until September 30 to cancel your registration and you will be reimbursed the course price and the production fee. However, the membership fee and a 50\$ administration fee will be non-refundable. Registration fees are non-refundable as of October 1st, 2020 onwards (except in case of a medical problem and conditional upon proof).

## **Free trial**

Each dancer is entitled to one free trial class in the first week of the season. However, you must sign your child up for this free trial in advance, in order to guarantee a spot in the class. This also allows us to ensure an appropriate number of students in the studios. To enroll your child in a free trial, contact the administration by email or phone.

## **Annual Fees**

1. Class fee : Course cost [See the website for cost list per class]
2. Annual membership fees: \$ 25 per person (or \$ 40 per family), regardless of the number of courses taken.
3. Production Fee: The production fees contribute to the elaboration of the end of year recital: room rental, equipment, costumes and recording the musical theatre voices. The costumes will be yours to keep with the exception of the borrowed costumes.
  - \$ 65 per child for dance classes and \$ 90 for musical theater classes.
  - For dancers following more than one course, this amount will be multiplied by the number of classes.

**Note:** *We understand that a variety of situations may make paying fees more difficult for some families. We invite families facing financial challenges to visit the administration in complete confidentiality to find a suitable solution.*

## **Language policy**

All dance classes are offered in French, an exciting way to experience Francophone culture to its fullest. All are welcome!

## **Attendance / Absences**

- La Girandole Association expects all students to arrive on time for classes. Please come to class ready to dance, this includes using the washroom prior to arrival and being dressed in advance. Children who do not arrive on time may be denied participation in the class.
- If you must be absent or are running late, please call our office as soon as possible at 780-468-0057 and send an email to the teacher.
- After two absences during the same session, the teacher may choose to withdraw the student from the end of the year show, if necessary.

**Parents, we expect you to support your child on your timeliness and class attendance.**

### **Drop off and pick up**

- Please drop your child off in front of La Girandole's office, 5 minutes before the start of the class so that they are ready to start the class on time
- We would appreciate it if you could pick your children up after class at a reasonable time, that is to say: 5 minutes in order to avoid crowding in common areas.
- We ask you to drop off and pick up your child at the office door and ask that the child enter alone.
- Minors are not allowed to leave alone, except with the written permission of a parent/guardian.
- We prefer that the students do not wait for you in the parking lot.

### **Lost and Found Items**

We will keep objects that are lost or left behind in a box at the office. Please contact the teacher or the office to let us know if you believe you have a missing item. We suggest you write your child's name on their water bottle to assist us with returning the item if need be.

### **Dancewear**

The Association La Girandole strives for excellence for its students. The dancers must therefore comply with the dress code required by the Association for the safety of all. The student should arrive in their dancewear. Their dance clothes must be clean. They must wear clean dance shoes in the studios at all times. Outdoor shoes must be removed at the entrance. Without dancing shoes, the student will not be allowed to enter the studio. In addition, each dancer must have their hair tied back at all times (bun for ballet lessons) and should not wear any jewelry during their class (watches, rings, necklaces, large earrings, etc.). The student will have to keep their things in the change room in a closed bag and will enter the studio with only a water bottle.

**We are counting on you to ensure that your child is prepared for class and understands our guidelines.**

### **Costumes**

The dancers will be able to keep the costumes at the end of the season with the exception of those borrowed from our storage. La Girandole Association's costumes are also available to rent. Please contact us for more information.

## **Annual Dance Recital**

Each year, the dance school presents a show at the end of the artistic season. If you expect that your child will not be able to participate in the show, we ask that you notify the teacher as soon as possible. The annual show is expected to take place on April 30, 2022 and the last week of classes will be on the week of April 23 to 29 2022.

## **Class observation**

To encourage learning and focus, parents will not be permitted in the studios during class hours. Parents and friends will be invited for a small presentation of the dances during a mini Holiday recital in Decembre (see the calendar). More details to come.

## **Studio guidelines:**

- Only water bottles will be allowed in La Girandole studios. Each dancer should bring a bottle of water labeled with their name to each class. A water fountain is available for the dancers in the change room.
- It is forbidden to chew gum during class, to eat in the studios, to touch the mirrors, to touch the sound system as well as the teachers' lockers.
- Since the dancers are not allowed to eat during their class, it is strongly suggested that each dancer has eaten a nutritious snack before their arrival at La Girandole (fruits, vegetables, nuts, etc.). If your child has more than one class in a row, they will be allowed to eat a snack in a designated area.
- La Girandole is not responsible for theft on its premises. Please leave your cell phones, video games, iPod / iPad, or other electronics and valuables at home.
- While waiting for your class please stay calm and refrain from running or disrupting others.
- Please leave the studio quickly after your class to facilitate the transition with the next class.
- Please behave with respect with other students, teachers and administration.
- Only clean dance shoes are allowed in La Girandole studios (no outdoor shoes).

## **Choreography and copyright**

The choreographies taught are the property of the teacher and the Association. It is forbidden to use the choreography elsewhere without the permission of the Association la Girandole.

## **Using photos and videos**

Unless otherwise stated by the child's parent or tutor, L'Association la Girandole reserves the right to use any visual recordings and photos taken during the dance season for promotional purposes on the school's website, Facebook page and printed material.

# Dancewear instructions for each class

Hair should always be tied, no jewelry should be worn and all clothes and shoes should be clean. Thank you!

## Kangourous and Lucioles

- Comfortable clothing (leotard, t-shirt, leggings, skirt or dance shorts)
- Ballet slippers or no-slide socks

## Étincelles, Alouettes, Zéphyr Junior

- Léotard, black tights or leggings, black traditional dance skirt, black gigue shoes
- T-shirt, leggings or soft sports pants, black gigue shoes

## Ballet - Jazz

- Leotard and tights
- T-shirt or sports top, soft sports pants or leggings
- Ballet shoes and jazz shoes

## Contemporary

- Leotard or sports top, leggings or dance shorts, black jazz shoes

## Musical Theater

- Comfortable and flexible clothing (no jeans) and black jazz shoes.

## Hip Hop

Comfortable clothing (no jeans) and black (if possible) indoor sports shoes (ex. VANS)

## Purchasing clothing and shoes at La Girandole

- We have a variety of dance shoes and some clothing that we offer to parents in exchange of a cash donation or another pair of shoes or piece of clothing.

- During the first week of classes, we will set up a table with the shoes and clothing that are available for exchange.

- We will be ordering black traditional dance skirts for those who need them. Please let us know if you are planning to order a skirt. We will be asking for \$50 that may be reimbursed if you chose to return your skirt at the end of the year and if it is in good condition.
