What if there is a waitlist?

Families will receive interim support from the Family Resource Network. This can include referrals to address outstanding needs or to other programs to bridge the gap.

If the referral was made through AHS, they can request updates from the Home Visitation Nurse.



What is the Home Visitation Program?

The **goal** of the Home Visitation Program is to support parents/ caregivers by building their parenting capacities and ability to nurture their child(ren) in their early childhood and development.

Different community agencies in and around Edmonton provide the Home Visitation Program. All agencies work under the same provincial guidelines, but many have adapted their programs to fit the needs of the community they serve.

Who qualifies?

People who are interested in long-term support in their home and who:

- Are pregnant, or
- Have a child/children under 6*

Families *may* be experiencing challenges with the social determinants of health – but this is not a requirement.

*Some agencies have expanded age criteria

How do families get connected to Home Visitation?

What supports do families receive?

Families will be offered 1 hour home visits weekly, biweekly, or monthly by a home visitor, depending on their individualized needs and goals. This may include:

- Parent education and skill development
- Child development information and activities
- Social connections
- Support accessing additional community resources
